

ALICE Training Institute® has additional e-Learning modules accessible to all K12 e-Learning users. These short modules are designed to enhance and support the staff in their training. Many educators have dual roles within the school and these modules incorporate ALICE strategies into those roles.



Administration - This module is designed to provide additional information specific for the administration team, such as principals, vice principals and administrative assistants.



Cafeteria/Food Service Workers - This module is designed to provide additional information for school employees who work specifically in the cafeteria.



Bus Driver - This module is designed to address the response options available to bus drivers and show how the ALICE strategies can work on the school bus.



Coaches - This module is designed to provide additional information specific to coaches of sports teams.



Custodial - This module discusses how custodians can use their knowledge of the building to assist during a violent event.



K-3 - This module focuses on age-appropriateness and ability levels when training very young children. It discusses the use of the book “I’m not scared, I’m prepared” to train children in the K-3 environment.



Pre-K Day Care - This module discusses the unique factors faced by pre-schools and daycare centers and provides guidance on how to respond to a violent event.



Support Staff - This module explains how the roles of school counselors, nurses and parent volunteers during a violent event.



Considerations for Students with Disabilities - This module is designed to provide additional information for educators and teams who are responsible for students with disabilities.
